**Agenda 4:** Brief overview, objective and 1st year working plan of bdNOG

#### **Discussion:**

Mailing list current member is 64. Planning to increase it to 1000 in next one year by promoting bdNOG to the wider community. Two event every year.

## **Discussion:**

Detail skeleton of the meeting is available on the presentation slides. Initially target was 80 participant. Feedback from the community was it will be more then 80. Need to prepare for minimum 150 participant. Initial budget was US\$ 16000 and host it in Pan Pacific Sonargaon. Comments form Zihad Bhai, Sumon Bhai, Biddut budget need to be close to US\$ 50, 000. Based on their past experience in SANOG hotel cost has gone significantly high and to achieve a standard already set by SANOG budget need to be increased and bdNOG conference standard has to be up to the mark of SANOG. Sumon bhai's comments on sponsorship investment need to be raised as well because it looks very reasonable. This statement was also supported by Zihad bhai, Biddut and others who were involved in past SANOG organization from Bangladesh. Roman's comments was at this stage bdNOG conference don't have any big value to the sponsors. We need to create values for bdNOG conference then we can think of increasing the sponsorship money. Almost everyone has supported 1st year plan and agreed that it is very much achievable. Towhid Bhai of Daffodil University has proposed the conference facility in his university as complimentary and invited to visit at a convenient time.

#### **Action items:**

1. Revisit the conference budget and prepare for minimum 150 participant.

- 2. Look for an alternate venue apart from Pan Pacific and Westin Dhaka and need to confirm the venue by end of November to secure the proposed conference date.
- 3. As plan B if the sponsorship response is not that good we should consider the offer of Towhid bha and host the entire event in Daffodil International University. Roman will go and visit the conference facility in Daffodil International University soon.
- 4. Need to work with the analytical minded people in bdNOG community and motivate them to start working on research papers to be presented in bdNOG1 conference.
- 5. We need to start the discussion on bdNOG mailing-list and make it active ASAP.

**Agenda 6:** Lightning talk on formation of bdNOG official Executive, Program and Advisory committee before the bdNOG1 Conference. Selection criteria etc.

#### **Discussion**:

bdNOG is still inviting Expression of Interest (EOI) from the community to serve the three committee of bdNOG. How many EOI received so far are listed on the presentation. Some selection criteria has been discussed as to be able to serve the EC the person need to be Citizen of Bangladesh and presented atleast one paper/tutorial/workshop in any of the NOG/APRICOT/APNIC conference. Sumon Bhai has proposed atleast 5 member need to be selected in the EC. Since bdNOG does not have any other internal working committee so this committee has a big responsibility to smoothly run bdNOG annual calendar. Roman being a current chair proposed Pappu as Co-Chair and it was supported by almost everyone in the room.

Roman also Proposed Simon to be part of the current working committee member and he will think about it and let Roman know his decision later. There was a comments about whether we can also host bdNOG website in Bangla. Pappu will work on this and host a Bangla version bdnOG website.

## **Action items:**

- 1. Need to select 5 suitable candidate for EC and PC by end of December and start working on the bdNOG1 conference preparation.
- 2. Will select EC/PC members only from the EOI sent through bdNOG website.

Selection criteria will be active contributor to the bdNOG mailing-list.
